Educational Publications

The Washington International Education Council publishes the first comprehensive guide to U.S. higher education in Chinese written and edited by U.S. educators. The magazine features articles explaining U.S. higher education and how Chinese students can apply to institutions in the United States. The magazine also includes articles on the application process for a student visa. Information on the diversity of higher education programs and institutions available to Chinese students is also included in the magazine.

Education Fairs and Tours

The Washington International Education Council has extensive experience in the successful operation of overseas study abroad fairs and tours. Tours are planned for China and other important regions for international student recruitment.

Educational Counseling and Placement

With over three decades of experience in educational counseling and placement, the staff of the Washington International Education Council offers assistance in the selection of appropriate institutions for students and the placement and administration of students or groups in programs that meet individual student needs and fit institutional requirements. The Council also provides advice to students in obtaining financial aid for higher education.

Seminars and Conferences

The Washington International Education Council organizes seminars and conferences to meet the needs of universities, language programs, and sponsoring organizations, including Education Attachés from government sponsors in Washington,

D.C.. WIEC Conferences provide an opportunity to meet with colleagues and counterparts to receive the latest information on regulations directly from United States government officials and to obtain vital information for international program administrators.

Faculty and Administrative Recruitment for Institutions Abroad

The Washington International Education Council assists foreign educational institutions in the recruitment of higher education personnel for programs located outside the United States. WIEC locates well qualified candidates for temporary or permanent assignments.

Design and Development of Study Abroad Programs

The Washington International Education Council also has substantial experience in the design and development of Study Abroad Programs. Programs can be designed to meet the needs of groups or individual international students coming to the United States or for North American institutions who will establish new programs abroad.

Credential Evaluation

The Washington International Education Council has the resources and knowledge to provide Credential Evaluation to students from any country wishing to study in the United States. Credential evaluation of studies completed outside of the United States is often required as part of the International Admission process.
